## Packing Checklist

### Identification

- Driver's License
- Children's Birth Certificates
- Your Birth Certificate
- Social Security Cards
- Work Permits/VISA
- Passport

### Financial

- Money and/or credit cards
- Bank books
- Checkbooks
- Public Assistance documentation
- Tax return from previous year
- Pay stubs for you
- Loan information

### Other Important Papers

- Your Protection Order
- Lease, rental agreement or house deed
- Car registration and insurance papers
- Health and life insurance papers
- Medical records for you and children
- Vaccination records
- Divorce papers
- Custody papers/agreements

### Household Items

- House and car keys
- Medications
- Address Book
- Phone cards
- Pictures of you, your children and your abuser
- Change of clothes for you and your children
- Children's toys (only their favorites)
- Jewelry
